The institution utilized Title IV Expected Family Contribution (EFC) eligibility to assist in determining HEERF grant allocation. Those students with a lower EFC (less than 5712) were allocated HEERF grant funds at both the Level 1 award and Level 2 award. Those students with a higher EFC (greater than 5712) or no EFC were only allocated a Level 2 HEERF grant award. All Students were allocated HEERF funds equitably based on their Title IV eligibility and the length of the course they were enrolled at the time of the allocation. The student must be enrolled and attending school or on a school approved Leave of Absence to receive the disbursement of HEERF grant funds.
